Neely. They will travel to a country unknown to them to engage and join others to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ. A typical day will include rising early and finishing their day late. What would such a journey be without making some sacrifices? Jesus made the ultimate sacrifice for us all when he gave up his life. His disciples continued to carry on the gospel and it is still being spread today. Peaches Henderson elaborated on the upcoming mission trip by saying: “Going to Haiti would be such a privilege. For a while now, I’ve dreamed and hoped of going on mission trips, of course to share the gospel of Christ, but to have a humbling and life changing experience as well. Often times, I take my daily life for granted. I feel as though life is “supposed” to be good for me, but then I have to realize that it isn’t the case at all. As I travel to Haiti, and hopefully other places in the future, each time, I hope to come back with a new appreciation of the life that Christ has provided to me.”
